Here is a map of Ghana and its surroundings. It is almost blank.

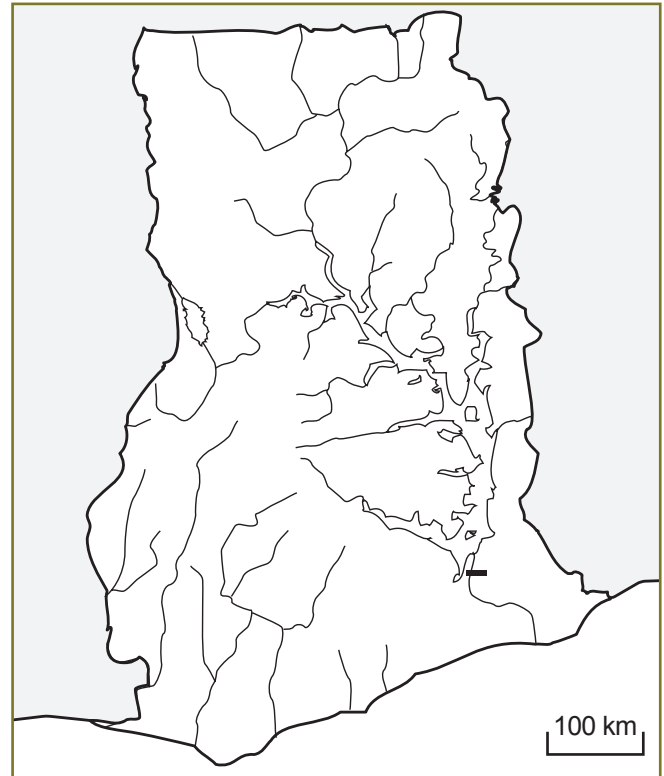
